- Construction of new steel framed plasterboard partitions
- Door frames and doors
- Security hatches
- Secure room zone 5 to meet Defences requirements
- Auto door
- Glazing
- Speed and Autex panelling
- Custom windows

Project Challenges

- Partitions high security
- Site access/secure sites all had to get passes to be on site
- No photos allowed secure site
- Site access through removed window on second floor with scissor lift for materials/tools, due to heritage building
- Custom m10 window was made for comms room

Coordination with Other Trades – Built Illusions, as the linings contractor, was required to coordinate its works with other client appointed Contractors, including services and finishing trades.
